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Policies and Procedures Contract Between Cooper and Resident-Fellow Policy

- I. PURPOSE:
 - A. To define responsibilities between Cooper, the GMEC and the resident/fellow
- II. POLICY:
 - A. Cooper, the GMEC, and the program directors assure that residents and fellows are provided with a written agreement of appointment outlining the terms and conditions of their appointment to a program in compliance with ACGME guidelines.
 - B. Cooper monitors programs with regard to implementation (by Program Directors) of terms and conditions of appointment through focus groups and the GME Office.
 - C. Cooper and the Program Directors ensure that residents and fellows are informed of and adhere to established educational and clinical practices, policies, and procedures in all institutions to which residents are assigned.
 - D. The Director of GME will present the proposed contract to the GMEC on an annual basis along with proposed stipends and position allocation. The GMEC may make recommendations to the DIO and Chief Medical Officer regarding resident/fellow stipends, benefits, and funding for resident/fellow positions.

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
