We will confirm your registration by email. Pre-course information and the website for the **mandatory pre-test** will be emailed to you upon receipt of your completed online registration. **COURSE REGISTRATION IS NOT CONFIRMED UNTIL YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE CONFIRMATION EMAIL. If you do not receive an email within 2 business days after submitting your online registration request, please contact the Life Support Training Center at (856) 342-2009.** It is suggested that all participants read the 2016 ACLS Provider Manual prior to coming to the course. The manual is available for purchase from the LSTC for \$40.00. (The manual is included for paying participants). Also available to help you prepare for this course is a 2015 Emergency Cardiovascular Care (ECC) handbook available through the Life Support Training Center for an additional \$30.00.

Refund Policy: Cooper Employees

A non-refundable cancellation fee of **\$100.00** will be charged to Cooper employees who cancel 2 weeks (14 days) prior to the date of the course.

A non-refundable "no-show" fee of **\$175.00** will be charged to Cooper employees who do not show for the course. (No exceptions).

Course Description:

The AHA's ACLS Course has been updated to reflect new science in the 2015 American Heart Association Guidelines for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Emergency Cardiovascular Care. This advanced course highlights the importance of team dynamics and communication, systems of care and immediate post-cardiac arrest care where case-based scenarios are presented. ACLS also covers airway management and related pharmacology.

For successful course completion, students must demonstrate skills competency in all learning stations, pass the CPR AED skills test, bagmask ventilation skills test and the Megacode test. They also must pass the written test with a score of 84% or higher. Upon successful completion, students receive an ACLS course completion card, valid for two years.

Intended Audience:

The ACLS Course is designed for healthcare professionals who either direct or participate in the management of cardiopulmonary arrest or other cardiovascular emergencies. This includes personnel in emergency response, emergency medicine, intensive care and critical care units such as physicians, nurses, and paramedics, as well as others who need an ACLS course completion card for job or other requirements

Prerequisites:

Participants must possess a current American Heart Association Basic Life Support card. **Copy of Current AHA BLS card must be uploaded to the registration site, if course was not taken at Cooper University Hospital. BLS must be current the day of course in order to register online.**

Participants must also possess a current American Heart Association ACLS provider card in order to register for an ACLS renewal course. **Copy of current AHA ACLS card must be uploaded to the registration site if course was not taken at Cooper Hospital.**

Please note: In order to register for an ACLS Renewal course, your current ACLS provider card must be current the day of the course date.
