The AHA's PALS Course has been updated to reflect new science in the 2015 AHA Guidelines for CPR & ECC. This classroom, video-based, Instructor-led course uses a series of simulated pediatric emergencies to reinforce the important concepts of a systematic approach to pediatric assessment, basic life support, PALS treatment algorithms, effective resuscitation and team dynamics. The goal of the PALS Course is to improve the quality of care provided to seriously ill or injured children, resulting in improved outcomes.

Intended Audience:

The PALS Course is for healthcare providers who respond to emergencies in infants and children.
