Notes:

Vacation: Residents choose four non-contiguous weeks of PTO throughout each program year to be used for vacation or conference time.

Electives: Up to 3 months of optional elective time may be taken during PGY-5. Electives offered include: pediatric neurosurgery, stereotactic radiosurgery, and endovascular neurosurgery.

Research:

During research rotations, residents are required to take Q4 hour call shifts at either Einstein Medical Center or Cooper University Hospital. Non-research rotations do not have dedicated research time built into the rotation, but residents are encouraged to participate in independent research studies with members of the faculty.
