

Precourse Information

Day 1 - BLS/Heartsaver Testing

All course participants will participate in a review of BLS and Heartsaver provider course skills and be expected to perform exemplary BLS psychomotor skills. Students must achieve a 90% or better on the BLS written exam and successfully complete the skills testing in order to receive an Instructor Candidate application and continue to Day 2 of the instructor course.

Day 2 - BLS classroom Faculty-led Instructor Course. (including BLS Instructor exam).

No monies will be refunded if you do not successfully complete the requirements of Day 1 or Day 2 of the course.

Upon receipt of your completed registration form and tuition payment, all candidates will receive the required manuals.

To help you prepare for this instructor course it is strongly recommended that all candidates attend a BLS course at Cooper University Hospital within 30 days of the instructor course.

Refund Policy: Cooper Employees

A non-refundable cancellation fee of \$125.00 will be charged to Cooper employees who cancel less than two weeks (14 days) prior to the date of the course.

A "no-show" fee of \$175.00 will be charged to Cooper employees who do not show for the course.

A fee of \$125.00 will be charged to Cooper employees who are unsuccessful in obtaining an Instructor candidate application on Day 1 of course.
